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Keysight Technologies Statement on Classification, Labelling and Packaging (EU Regulation 1272/2008/EC)

Keysight Technologies, Inc. is aware of its obligations in the European Union under the regulation regarding classification, labelling and packaging of substance and mixtures, referred to as CLP 1272/2008/EC, which came into force January 20, 2009, and is directly applicable to industry.

CLP is based on the United Nations Globally Harmonised System (GHS) of classification aiming to harmonize the classification and hazard communication of chemicals (label and safety data sheet, now referred to as SDS). It ensures a high level of protection of human health and the environment and lowers barriers for global trade.

Keysight continues to ensure classification and labelling of all substances are in accordance with the GHS criteria. This includes but is not limited to:

- Classify in accordance with new classification requirements set forth in EU Regulation 1272/2008/EC
- Offer Safety Data Sheets (SDS's) which includes updated CLP classification information
- Ensure product package labelling meets all new labelling requirements
- Compliance to product packaging per EU Regulation 1272/2008/EC.
