## Agilent E6651A Mobile WiMAX™ Test Set - Installation and Use of Third Party Software - Policy

The E6651A Mobile WiMAX Test Set includes a Windows XP operating system running on an embedded PC; the license for this software is part of the package. Other than the temporary use of Anti-Virus software, Agilent Technologies strongly recommends that users **DO NOT** install any third party software on the E6651A.

**Installation of any third party software is performed at the users risk.**

- 1** As with all software, additional patches may cause a change in performance that could adversely affect the operation of the E6651A. Therefore, we recommend that you should not apply Windows' patches delivered through Windows Update, Microsoft Update, Microsoft Download Center, or any other means.
- 2** The E6651A does not ship with Anti-Virus software and Agilent Technologies does not supply Anti-Virus software. Where you wish to check the instrument for virus contamination you should install your own Anti-Virus software, perform a check, and immediately uninstall the Anti-Virus software. Use the procedure detailed in the Agilent E6651A WiMAX Test Set Virus Scanning Procedure document.
- 3** To prevent LAN-borne virus infection, we advise you to only connect the E6651A to a private LAN that does not provide access to the internet or any corporate LAN.
- 4** To prevent USB flash memory-borne virus infection, you should scan USB flash memory devices immediately before connection to the Agilent E6651A Test Set.
